Tick off the challenges as you go, how many can you complete?

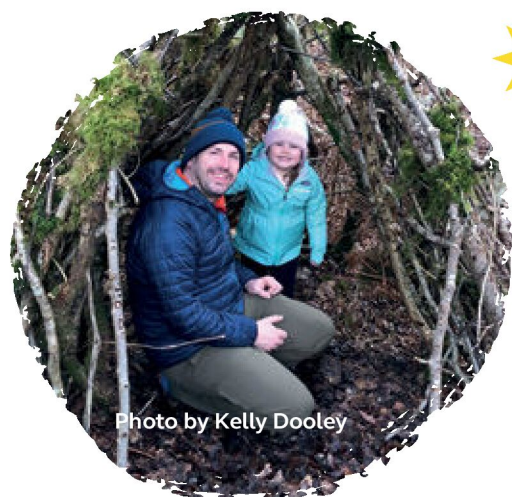

1. Make a leaf painting Find some interesting leaves and paint one side, press them down on your paper and peel them back to reveal a beautiful leaf print.

2. Toast marshmallows Grab a clean stick or skewer and pop a marshmallow or two on the end, hold over the fire until it starts turning golden brown.

3. Play poohsticks Can be played on any bridge over running water; each player drops a stick on the upstream side of a bridge and the one whose stick first appears on the other side is the winner.

4. Investigate a beach rock pool Take your net and bucket for a little dipping, but remember to return any finds to the rock pool you took them from.

5. Roll down a hill Challenge your friends and family to a hill rolling race!

6. Go on a nature walk with your family There are so many interesting nature finds to be discovered.

7. Make paperchains Perfect for a wet afternoon, use strips of coloured paper and link together with a spot of glue.

8. Fly a kite Catch some air and reach for the skies. If you don't have your own kite you could make one with a little string, paper and wood.

9. Make snow angels Or sand angels on the beach, or leaf angels in autumn! Lie down and spread your 'wings' sweeping them up and down to make an angel impression.

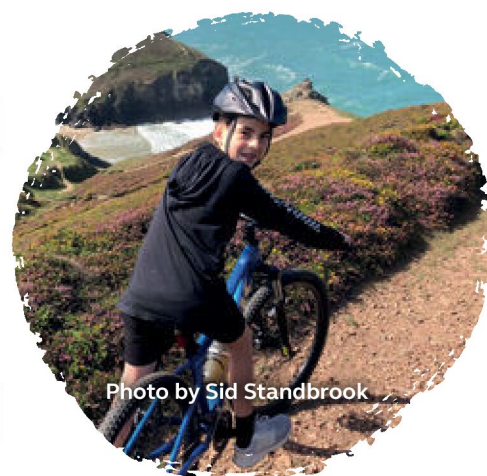

These recipes are great for making all year round, for picnics, parties and for taking on adventures! Ask an adult for a helping hand before you start...

Icy treats for hot days

Lollipops are wonderfully fun to make. Here are some ideas to get you started.

What you need:

- Squash/cordial
- Lemonade
- Sprinkles
- Berries
- Lollipop freezer moulds

What to do:

1. Choose your favourite cool drink – squash, fruit juice, cordials and lemonade all make excellent lollies.
2. When mixing your drink make it slightly stronger than you would if you were drinking it. Once the mixture is cold it loses a little flavour, so you need to boost it up.
3. Next is the fun part – add in any fun decorative twists you can think of – maybe some rainbow sprinkles, or a few blueberries. Why not chop up some strawberries or raspberries.
4. Once you have your mixture pour it into your lolly mould and leave in the freezer overnight.
5. Then they are ready to enjoy.



UK S'mores

This American campfire treat is so much fun to make and is easy enough to do with a couple of British substitutions.

You need:

- One packet of plain biscuits
- One packet of marshmallows
- Some thin milk chocolate
- A long clean stick or skewer
- A BBQ

What to do:

1. Take a hobnob and place a piece of chocolate flat on top.
2. Next pop a marshmallow on the end of your skewer and hold it over the glowing embers of your BBQ.
3. Once the marshmallow begins to bubble and change colour carefully place it on top of the chocolate and use a second biscuit on top to create a 'sandwich'.
4. Using the biscuit sandwich as a clamp, carefully slide the stick or skewer out of the marshmallow.
5. Enjoy!

Easy Peasy Melting Fork Biscuits

These lovely little biscuits are great fun to make and so simple, they melt in the mouth and are very moreish.

You need:

- 3oz plain flour
- 1oz custard powder
- 1oz icing sugar
- 3oz of soft margarine

What to do:

1. Take all your ingredients and pop them in a bowl.
2. Use a fork to stir them up.
3. Watch as they slowly begin to form a dough.
4. Finish the dough with your hands by kneading it together.
5. Roll the dough into a long sausage.
6. Divide the sausage into 16.
7. Roll each piece into a ball.
8. Press each ball with the prongs on your fork to give the tops a little pattern and to flatten the balls into discs.
9. Bake at 350°F/176°C for 15 mins.
10. Yum!

Warming baked potato soup

A twist on the classic baked potato with beans and cheese, this is a wonderfully warming supper after a day exploring.

What you need:

- A tin of beans
- Grated cheddar cheese
- Potatoes
- Tomato puree
- A little water

What to do:

1. Pop your potatoes in the microwave, or wrap them in tin foil and put them in the oven, ask an adult for help with this.
2. Once your potatoes are cooked through scoop out the fluffy potato and mash with as much grated cheese as you like.
3. Over the hob in a saucepan, pour in your baked beans and gently heat through.
4. Once the beans are warm add in the cheesy potato slowly and stir together, add a little water to loosen the mixture until it is the consistency of soup you want.
5. If you've added quite a bit of water add a good tablespoon of the tomato puree to taste.
6. Serve up with crusty bread to dunk.



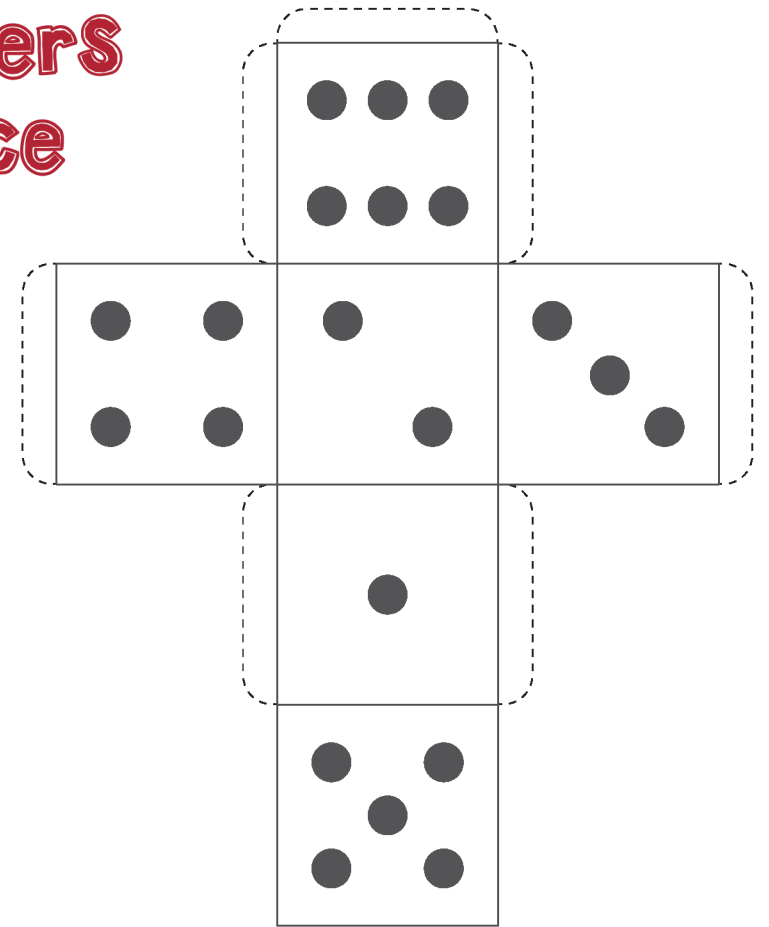


Snakes & Ladders board game dice

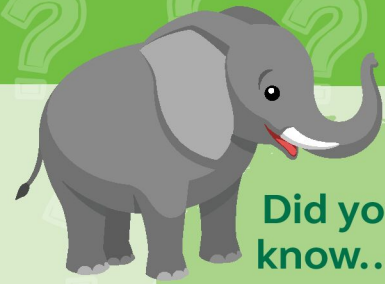

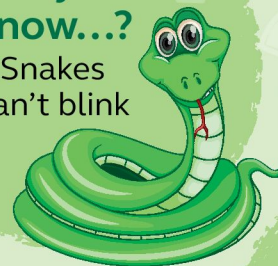

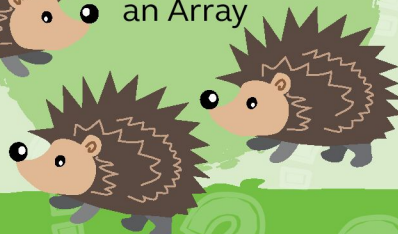
